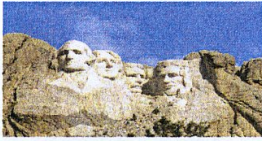

Up Coming Work Days

We are scheduling upcoming work days to get ready for the season. We will be cleaning the Harkrader Barn and preparing to move wood that is being stored in the Lukens Barn to the Harkrader Barn. We will then be cleaning and preparing the Lukens Barn to receive a new floor so the equipment that we have can be moved and stored in the Lukens Barn. After this has been completed we will be cleaning out the headshed so we will have easy access and an area to work on various equipment or items around the Village. There will be several heavy items that will need to be moved during these work days. Gravel needed for Roadway around the Village and as a base for the flooring in the Lukens Barn

It is very muddy and wet around the Village due to all the snow we have received over the last few weeks. Anyone who comes to the Village will either need to park in the parking lot or stay on the driveway. If you get off in the grass you will most likely get stuck in the mud and will leave ruts in the grass. We already have several that will take us quite a while to fix once the weather breaks.

We have need for gravel to be placed around the roadway and we will also need a base of gravel placed in the barn for the flooring. We currently have a price quote of \$13 per ton. For the amount of gravel that we need this will be quite a sum of money that will be needed to get everything ready for this year's season.

Furnas House - Built 1828



The Furnass Cabin has holes in the roof that let moisture and animals in. The floor is falling in and there are holes in the walls that need to be filled in. For the first time since it was moved to PV, the Furnass House could not be opened for our Candlelight Walk 09 because the floors were too weak for a group to stand on. We need your help!!

The Furnass Cabin is only ONE cabin that is in dire need of repairs - every cabin at Pioneer Village needs work on them. All need roofs which we are starting to get on - one cabin at a time. But they all need painting, chinking (filling in the space between the logs), and logs replaced. We have the materials - we just need the manpower to do the repairs.
